## ODOT Employee Transportation Options Program

ODOT is actively developing an Employee Transportation Options Program to support and encourage the availability, awareness and use of transportation options among ODOT employees. This collaborative agency-wide effort is consistent with ODOT's core mission and values, the Oregon Transportation Plan (OTP) and the newly drafted statewide Oregon Transportation Options Plan.

ODOT supports Transportation Options to enhance the performance of the existing transportation system by reducing single occupancy vehicle trips for commuting and for meetings. This, in turn, reduces greenhouse gas emissions and enhances quality of life for Oregonians, including ODOT employees.
